



7.1.3 C Liquid Waste Management in HEI

Liquid waste primarily consists of sewage or blackwater from the washrooms. The sewage is collected through well-maintained drainage pipelines managed by the Institute. These pipelines connect to a system of chambers that channel the waste into the BMC's Liquid Waste Management System. Once transferred, the civil council oversees the management of the liquid waste and the BMC treats it using scientific methods to ensure effective waste management.
